## Electrical technician (M/F) Permanent contract - Full-time (37h30)

The EEB1 is part of the European Schools system and provides education for children whose parents work for the European institutions. ### JOB DESCRIPTION AND MAIN TASKS

Reporting to the Senior Technician and the School's Deputy Director of Finance and Administration, the Technician is responsible for :

- Reading and interpreting electrical diagrams ;
- Installing civil and industrial electrical systems in compliance with the GREI ;
- Carrying out servicing and maintenance on electrical installations, equipment and systems (lighting, emergency lights, switches, circuit breakers, differential switches, remote control switches, etc.);
- Identifying and repairing electrical faults and malfunctions ;
- Testing and checking installed and repaired electrical systems;
- Correcting and certifying that installations comply with standards on the basis of AIB reports;
- Install and maintain computers, smartboards and other IT equipment;
- Helping the technical team move furniture and equipment and carrying out other logistical tasks;
- Assisting the senior technician in maintaining the telephony / doorphone system;
- Carrying out minor repairs;
- Working with the workshop on various projects for events such as the school fête;
- Carrying out various joinery jobs and minor furniture repairs;
- Various plumbing jobs, minor repairs to taps and toilets, unblocking and repairs;
- Checking the operation of radiators throughout the school, technical installations and HVAC;
- Preparing, organising and setting up rooms for parties and meetings (setting up and monitoring audio-visual facilities for school events, which may take place in the evening or even at weekends).

## PROFILE REQUIRED

- At least a higher secondary technical training, type A2 in electricity, electromechanics (preferably A1 training in electricity or electromechanics);
- Knowledge of electrical engineering and HVAC regulation ;
- Skills in the design, installation and maintenance of electrical systems;
- Skills in assembling and wiring civil and industrial switchboards and cabinets;
- Knowledge of the tools and equipment used by electricians;
- Have the BA4/BA5 or be ready to take it;
- Excellent command of French, knowledge of English ;
- At least 5 years' experience in a similar role;
- A focus on safety in the workplace ;
- Compliance with internal procedures, instructions and standards in force;
- Flexible organisation and respect for deadlines;
- Versatility, resourcefulness and a sense of responsibility;
- Resistance to stress and dynamism ;
- Excellent communication skills in a demanding multilingual context;
- Proactivity and initiative;
- Excellent physical condition (standing, working on site and at heights);
- Possible availability outside predefined working hours in an emergency and/or at the exceptional request of Management.
